Holidays in term time

May we please remind you that holidays in term time can not be authorised. If you require time off of school for your child for an exceptional reason, there is a form in the school office to make this request. Exceptional reasons are those that are rare and would not apply to many others.

Requests should be made at least two weeks before. If the request is not authorised by the Headteacher, then the code 'G' has to be placed in the register and as a consequence the Local Authority may issue you with a Fixed Penalty notice of £120 per child; per parent. This reduces to £60 if paid within a set time.
